
Dear Neenah.

With the four-year anniversary of the Little Lake Trestle Loop coming up, Future Neenah is announcing the "Log Your Loops" fourth annual initiative this summer to get people out enjoying this fantastic recreational amenity again. Log Your Loops 2021 was a success with 1,191 people registering and 305 claiming a T-shirt for doing 50+ loops (that's over 45,750 miles!).

With the community's continued enthusiasm for the Loop, we believe the 2022 numbers will be even bigger.

Memorial Day through Labor Day (99 days!) trestle loop users can Log their Loops to earn a T-shirt award as they use the trail. A full loop is just over 5k. Electric Scooters Have Arrived In Neenahl

The City of Neenah and Bird, a leader in environmentally friendly electric transportation, have teamed up to bring shared e-scooters to the city. Bird partners closely with the cities (over 350) in which it operates to provide a reliable and affordable transportation option for people who live, work and visit there. The scooters began to arrive on April 25 and will remain through the summer.

The eco-friendly transportation option can be activated through Bird's free mobile phone application and used to replace gaspowered car trips when going to the store, meeting up with friends, exploring the community and taking many other daily trips.

A few things to remember when riding scooters in the City of Neenah:

- You must be 18 or older to ride.
- Only one rider per Bird.
- Ensure you stick to riding on the road in Downtown Neenah; riding on the sidewalk is prohibited.
- The Bird app will indicate areas of "preferred parking." Riders can stop their ride in these locations to receive a discount on their next ride.
- When parking the scooters, keep scooters in an upright position with two wheels making point of contact with the ground. Ensure that the sidewalk is free from obstruction.
- The app will not allow riders to end their ride on all bridges, over passes and roundabouts.
- Scooters are prohibited in the parking ramp and skate park.

Geo fencing, which is controlled by the Bird Scooter company, allows for the speed control, where scooters can be ridden, as well



as nesting (preferred parking) locations. There are bells and lights on the scooter to bring driver/pedestrian awareness of the scooter.

See a scooter being improperly ridden or parked? In the bottom left corner of the Bird mobile app, click on the Community Mode icon and file a report. Otherwise, you can contact Bird by email at hello@bird.co or at their 24/7 support line +1(866) 205-2442.

Costs & Options: .39 a minute + \$1 to start -or-Single ride pass at \$6.99 for up to 45 minutes and 1 day pass at \$11.99

TRAIL EXTENSION

Bridgewood Trail Extension at Jewelers Park Drive

You may have noticed the recent construction near The Best Western Premier Bridgewood Resort Hotel & Conference Center and the Jewelers Mutual Insurance offices – the creation of another trail option for the community's enjoyment!

 What Is The Total Length of The Trail? The trail currently being constructed is 0.9 miles. In conjunction with the existing trails along Harrison Street and the Bridgewood pond, it creates a 2.1 mile loop.

On VS Off Road:

All the trail is off-street. There is a section along Jewelers Park Drive where the trail is attached to the road as essentially a 12-foot wide sidewalk.

Is The Trail All Paved?

All of the trail will be paved. The new section is concrete except for the boardwalk and the north bridge. The existing trail is asphalt.

- Anticipated Completion Date: Memorial Day weekend. The last part of the project is landscaping restoration, which will take a couple of weeks.
- Will it be maintained year-round as an all-seasons trail? Yes.
- Is this an expansion or connection to the previous, existing trail that was in place there?

The new trail ties into the previously existing trails but also extends that trail to the Cecil Street/Green Bay Road intersection.

 Route Map: See the rough trail map rendering.

New Bridge:

There is a new bridge on the north end of the trail and a boardwalk about 0.25 mile south of Cameron Way.

 Is it self-contained trail loop or does it connect to any other sidewalks or trails?

The trail loop has connections to the Cecil/Green Bay intersection and to side streets at Bridgewood, Hickory, Baldwin, Reddin and Fairwood.



It made us think about all the years ('82-'98) that Marigen Carpenter spent as Mayor and now newly elected Mayor Jane Lang serves our community.

This was especially meaningful to us as an all-female Future Neenah office team!

In 2020, the City of Neenah began the process of repairing Lakeshore Avenue which had greatly deteriorated over the years. As part of that process the city opted to create a walkway along the road. That walkway will now be recognized as the Helen Kimberly Stuart Trail in honor of Helen's contributions to the city over its long history. Helen was the oldest daughter of John Alfred Kimberly, one of the four founders of Kimberly and Clark Corporation. She was the first woman alderman in the city (1930) and the



first woman to run for mayor. She fought to keep the beautiful Lakeshore drive open to the public when it might have become a private road. We have her to thank for her foresight in the preservation of what she referred to as "Neenah's beauty spot." Amongst many other accomplishments, Helen was also a founder of the Neenah Historical Society. Thank you, Helen, for all you did for Neenah. We remember you and appreciate your dedication to this community!

WHAT'S IN A NAME? FUTURENEENAH

t's back! This is the second in a series of why Neenah businesses named themselves what they did – the significance or the deep thoughts and reasoning behind why they chose their business name. Some have personal meanings with a fascinating back story while others are quite simple or literal. Some names are just unique and evoke a natural curiosity to learn what they mean. Similar to naming a child, a business is your baby born of love and hard work! You name that 'child' after a beloved relative, a respected individual or something with a deep personal meaning in your life.



Keith Schreiner, owner of **Broken Tree Pizza** tells his story, "One day someone asked me a simple question, 'What's your



first memory of pizza?' I remembered the day my father introduced me to pepperoni pizza - a day I hadn't thought about in 30 years. It was a brisk fall day and I was in first grade. My mother

picked me up from school and told me that the oak tree in our back yard had fallen over onto our deck. My father was going to need my help with cleaning up the tree. When we were finished, we were cold, tired and hungry. My father decided to order a pizza for us. Having pizza delivered was a treat for us. I ate that first piece and was confused. I had to ask my father, 'Why does the sausage taste so different?' 'It's not sausage,' he told me, 'it's pepperoni.' I had never tasted anything so alive in my life! It was spicy, savory, crispy and delicious. Looking back that is the day my taste buds came alive. That's it - my first pizza memory. Memories - of tasting something that woke me up, of reward after a hard day of work, of my father and time spent with him, of discovery, of what I wanted to create for myself, my family and my community. What is your first memory of pizza? What is your Broken Tree?"

Matt Gloede explains, "**Santé** first and foremost means "health," but informally it means "cheers!" It's what French culture uses when they clink glasses to celebrate one's health or just a nice glass of wine. My husband, Zach, and I both love Paris (it's where we got engaged). We love French culture, wine, and cuisine so we knew



we wanted to name the place something in French. However, a lot of French words are difficult to say! Eventually we landed on Santé; as soon as he said it, I knew it fit and I fell in love with the name."

WHAT'S IN A NAME?

Debbie Rasmus shares, "Cannova is my maiden name. When my grandfather started it in 1921, it was a grocery store/ tavern in Illinois. Over the years it continued to evolve through the generations, however the name remained. It's who we are. The



surname Cannova is derived from the Italian word "canova" meaning cupboard, cellar, or food store. Cannova's has been in downtown Neenah since 2005.

Rachel Bowers-Lau of **Sankalpa Salon** on Commercial Street, said, "Choosing a name for your business is hard. I was looking for something that carried through in all aspects



of my life but would also carry through and have meaning for our guests and future

shareholders of our company. Sankalpa came to me when

I was on a yoga/surfing/spin class retreat in Costa Rica. Sankalpa is a Sanskrit word that means the art of intention formed in the heart and mind. It's an intention that's set to bring about a positive change to one's life."

BEAMING is an acronym for BRINGING EQUINE ASSISTED MOBILITY INTO NEW GROWTH. Center Director Katie Samuelson explained, "While we change Lives One Ride at Time, our vision was to facilitate life



changing experiences for all involved with the aid of our equine (horse) companions. Our goal was always to overcome the challenges of today, while continually growing to meet the needs of tomorrow. As BEAMING has grown this has really become a great way for all to look at what the word means to us! We now are the second place in the Nation to offer Alzheimer's and dementia clients services. This is an evidence-based research program but Neenah is one of two places in the US doing it in its second year, we served all populations at BEAMING and invite all volunteers as well to join us."

Courtney Holcomb, former owner, of Waveforms Pilates describes her process of identifying a name. "I took a trip to Denver for Pilates education and treated it like a sabbatical to think about business. Refueled after my trip, I returned with ideas for a name. I searched online to discover many were already claimed or too similar to existing businesses. My husband decided we needed to pick a name we liked to file for an LLC.

Once filed, we could name a studio under that LLC as anything we wanted. This gave us more time to think. When I was out for a day, he sent in a request for Waveforms.



Being a musician of synthesizers, he dealt with waveforms all day and thought it sounded cool. Coming home, he told me he filed as Waveforms, LLC. We hadn't discussed a name close to this. I felt something I'd spent so much time thinking about was simplified to something I didn't feel related to the business. For a few days, I tried to come up with new names for our LLC. But, the more I sat with Waveforms, connections started to come together. Suddenly, it was clear to me! My husband's music world and my movement world collided. The body does just what this definition describes, patterns of movement. Sometimes simple and literal really is perfect and Peter from **Zuppas** kept it brief. He picked the name Zuppas

for his restaurant because he wanted to provide amazing soups and because Zuppas.com was available at that time and isn't it perfect?
